How to become a signatory to the Child Friendly Cities and Communities Charter



This step-by-step guide has been developed to assist your organisation to formally endorse the Victorian Child Friendly Cities and Communities (CFCC) Charter.

- **Step 1:** Explore the three principles of the CFCC Charter and United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child.

- **Step 2:** Brief your Senior Management and CEO on the principles of the CFCC Charter and benefits of becoming a signatory.

The CFCC Advisory Group and Network are here to assist you. Contact the CFCC Advisory Group to request key facts, research, presentations and engagement techniques.

Step 3: Make a formal request for adoption of the CFCC Charter with support from your team and manager. Develop a report with the recommendation to become a signatory to the CFCC Charter.

The CFCC Advisory Group can provide support with content to include in your report, such as CFCC Charter alignment with your organisation's policies, standards and legislative requirements.

Step 4: Once your organisation has adopted the CFCC Charter, write to the VLGA and advise them of the adoption. Your organisation will then receive a confirmation letter and signatory certificate.

Share the news that your organisation is now a signatory to the CFCC Charter through internal communications and external social media.

Step 5: Develop strategies to embed the CFCC Charter in your organisation.

Participate in the CFCC Network meetings to learn about what other organisations are doing and share how your organisation is embedding the CFCC Charter.
