





HART Awards 2021 Call for Nominations

The HART Awards, unique in the Victorian landscape, recognise local Victorian initiatives and champions that make a real difference in their community and that contribute to local reconciliation outcomes.

Nominations are sought for initiatives that demonstrate Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and non-Aboriginal people working together and programs that have contributed to relationships, respect and understanding and demonstrate a commitment to Aboriginal self-determination.

Winners each receive a handcrafted HART Award. The winners of the Community Category and the Schools/Early Years Category will also receive \$1000 each to support their future reconciliation work.

The shortlisted and winning initiatives will be profiled in a booklet and promoted by the VLGA, Reconciliation Victoria, Maggolee and Bank Australia to provide inspiration for other organisations and communities.

The 2021 HART Awards winners will be announced on Friday 4 June 2021.

Nominations close at 4 pm Sunday 21 March 2021.
